- **Honeysuckle** - dine at one of our waterfront cafes or restaurants and discover Newcastle's maritime heritage at The Maritime Centre, Lee Wharf ([Map 1 N-5](#))
- **The Foreshore** - enjoy a leisurely stroll along the Foreshore Promenade from Honeysuckle to Nobbys ([Map 1 M-5](#))
- **Queens Wharf** - climb the Queens Wharf Tower (40.3m high) for spectacular views of the city and coastline ([Map 1 R-5](#))
- **Newcastle East Heritage Walk** - follow the steps of Newcastle's 200 year journey. See pgs 30 & 31 of the free visitors guide. ([starting from Map 1 S-5](#))
- **Foreshore Park** - fabulous playground for the kids and great undercover BBQ facilities ([Map 1 V-5](#))
- **Convict Lumber Yard** - explore Newcastle and Australia's industrial heritage ([Map 1 T-5](#))
- **Nobbys** - walk to the end of the breakwater past the Pasha Bulker sculpture and lighthouse and enjoy the magnificent views ([Map 1 V-3](#))
- **Bathers Way** - a 5km walk along Newcastle's stunning coastline. See pages 28 & 29 of the free visitors guide. ([starting from Map 1 V-4](#))
- **Fort Scratchley** - tunnel into the Fort's rich military history ([Map 1 V-5](#))
- **Newcastle Beach & Ocean Baths** - swim in the Art Deco Newcastle Ocean Baths (opened in 1922). ([Map 1 U-7](#))
- **Bogey Hole** - revisit Newcastle's convict past with a visit to the convict-hewn ocean bath, built around 1820. ([Map 1 R-10](#))
- **King Edward Park** - 19th century King Edward Park and rotunda date back to the earliest days of Newcastle ([Map 1 Q-9](#))
- **The Obelisk** - a prominent feature on Newcastle's skyline, was once used as a guiding landmark for ships approaching the port of Newcastle ([Map 1 Q-8](#))
- **Christchurch Cathedral** - a fully restored masterpiece. Beautiful grounds and views surround the city's 'Castle' ([Map 1 R-6](#))
- **Hunter Street Mall** - the CBD's main shopping strip, including David Jones ([Map 1 R-5](#))
- **Darby Street** - funky inner city 'eat street', also great for shopping and art lovers ([Map 1 N-8](#))
- **Newcastle Regional Art Gallery** - one of Australia's leading regional galleries with a magnificent collection ([Map 1 O-7](#))
- Just a little further out experience boutique shopping and dining at **The Junction** ([Map 1 I-11](#))
- Or the cosmopolitan feel of **Beaumont Street** with the many sidewalk cafes and nightlife. ([Map 1 D-3](#))
- **Blackbutt Reserve** - home to a wide variety of Australian wildlife including koalas, kangaroos, and birds. Also great bushwalking trails. ([Map 2 H-6](#))





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
